4. Zoom Video Conferences

Class Zoom Conferences have been very well attended across all classes.

- Years 3 to 6 classes are holding daily Zooms.
- Year 2 are holding two Zooms per week
- Kindergarten and Year 1 are hold at least one Zoom per week.

Other tips

- <u>For Google Classrooms</u>- Year 3-6 students, it is important that students have logged into the DoE Portal and entered the Google classrooms via the DoE Portal- no short cuts!

<u>Logging out of other Zoom Accounts</u>- It is also important that all other Zoom accounts on the
device been signed-logged out. In many cases students who are finding it difficult to get into
a Zoom meeting, it is because their connection is defaulting to another person's Zoom
account.
