

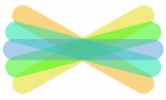


Seesaw for Year 3 Classes

Teachers in Year 3 and 3/4PM will be using Seesaw to share learning and communicate with families. It will also be the platform that students will use to complete weekly homework.

Seesaw can be accessed by using a computer, or through a phone or tablet by downloading two apps. An invitation to access the Family App (Family Invite) and Class App (Home Learning Code) is attached.

In the Family App parents/carers can view student work, photographs and reminders. A notification will be received when there is a new post.

Parents/carers will be able to communicate with their child's teacher by commenting on items that have been posted.

Rules of Engagement

Communications will be monitored from 9am – 3pm on weekdays and will not necessarily be monitored out of hours. Teachers will respond within a 48 hour, Monday-Friday period.
