Videos can be submitted through the BSPS Harmony Google Classroom. All Years 3-6 students should be aware of how to access the Google space, through the student portal. We ask that parents of K-2 students contact their child's class teacher via Seesaw, to request their child's username and password information (if your child is unsure or unaware of the details). The Google Classroom code is 7ericip.
