



# NSW PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

Dear Parents / Carers,

Blacktown South Public School has participated in the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge since its inception. We encourage all students to participate in the challenge.

Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 students are not required to do anything as the school reads the books, records their participation and validates their records. All of this is completed by teachers at school.

In Years 3, 4, 5 and 6, students are required to read their books and enter the PRC ID number for the book on their online record. Students can access the PRC platform by searching for the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge on any search engine then they can login using their usual department login and password.

Students in Years 3-6 are required to read twenty books to complete the challenge. Ten must be from the official PRC booklist (available on the PRC website) and ten can be personal choices.

Once students have completed the challenge they should inform Mr Arundel in the library and he will validate their record.

The PRC for 2025 officially starts on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February. From that date students can access the platform and start registering books they have read. We encourage students to start reading now and include books they read before that date on their record.

The challenge concludes on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2025. After that day students can no longer enter books on their record. All completed challenges will be validated after that date and certificates issued towards the end of term 4.
