Teachers in Kindergarten, Year One and Year Two will be using Seesaw to share learning and communicate with families. It will also be the platform that students will use to complete weekly homework.

Seesaw can be accessed by using a computer, or through a phone or tablet by downloading an app. An invitation to access your child's class (Family Invite) and homework (Home Learning Code) is attached.

Class Page



On the class page, parents/carers can view student work, photographs and reminders. A notification will be received when there is a new post in the child's journal.

Parents/carers will be able to communicate with their child's teacher by commenting on a private note. This will only be visible to the class teacher.

Rules of Engagement

Communications will be monitored from 9am – 3pm on weekdays and will not necessarily be monitored out of hours. Teachers will respond within a 48 hour, Monday-Friday period.

We ask that parents/carers making comments on posts show respect by ensuring discussions remain civil. We reserve the right to remove comments that do not adhere to the rules of engagement including comments that:

- Are deemed racist, sexist, abusive, profane, violent, obscene, spam
- Are wildly off topic
- Libel, incite, threaten or make personal character attacks on BSPS students and employees

In order to complete homework activities, students will need to login to the app or login at app.seesaw.me by selecting 'I'm a Student'. Students can only complete activities and post work from the Class App.
